Accomplishments

- In collaboration with the Episcopal PME Directors & contributing writers, produced the 2011 edition of the Mission Education Curriculum for the Women's Missionary Society of the African Methodist Episcopal Church. The General Theme was "Environmental & Climate Change: Our Christian Responsibility". The Geographic Theme was India.
- Conducted the Annual PME Dialogue in Baltimore, Maryland, where 24 persons including Episcopal PME Directors and contributing writers were trained in developing the mission education curriculum.
- The Connectional PME Director and 16 Episcopal PME Directors promoted Mission Education through yearbook monthly study, workshops, brochures, flyers and Missionary Annual Days.
- The yearbook sales continue to be an important source of revenue for the department and the WMS.
